

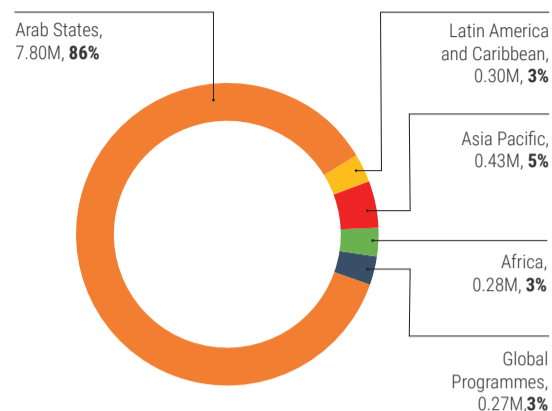

2022 earmarked income allocation by UN-Habitat implementing region



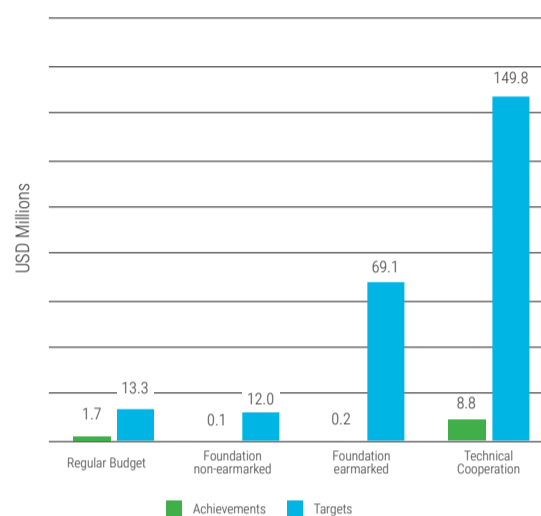
